## Fast 21: Angels — their functions

 According to the Holy Quran, the most prominent function of the angel, in the spiritual realm, is the bringing down of Divine revelation or the communication of Divine messages to the prophets.

Fast 21 1



- The prophet not only sees the angel but also hears his voice, and the
  angel is to him, therefore, a reality. This was the universal experience
  of humanity through their great religious figures in all ages. As the
  angel is an immaterial being, the prophet sees him sometimes in the
  shape of a human being and sometimes in other forms.
- According to the Holy Quran, the angel who brought revelation to the Holy Prophet is known by the name of Gabriel (2:98), the Arabic form of which is *jibrīl*. Gabriel is also mentioned in the Quran as *Rūḥ al-Amīn* or the Faithful Spirit (26:193–194), and *Rūḥ al-Qudus* or the Holy Spirit (16:102). Gabriel or the Faithful Spirit or the Holy Spirit is said to have revealed the Quran to the Holy Prophet.

Fast 21 2



- The revelation to the prophets who appeared before the Holy Prophet Muhammad is said to have been granted to them in a similar manner as to the Holy Prophet (4:163).
- Angels also brought revelation to other righteous servants of God who were not prophets, as for example the Quran says about Mary (Maryam, the mother of Jesus):

"And when the angels said, O Mary, surely Allah has chosen you and purified you and chosen you above the women of the world." - 3:42, see also 3:45.

 Angels generally are said to bring revelation to righteous Muslims as stated in the Quran:

Fast 21 3



"As for those who say, Our Lord is Allah, then continue in the right way, the angels descend upon them, saying: Do not fear, nor grieve, and receive good news of the Garden which you were promised." — 41:30

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- Angels also strengthen the righteous servants of God, prophets as well as others, and give them comfort in trials and afflictions. Jesus Christ is mentioned in the Quran as being strengthened with the Holy Spirit (2:87, 2:253, 5:110), and the believers generally are said to be strengthened with the Holy Spirit:
  - "These are they into whose hearts He has impressed faith, and strengthened them with a Spirit from Himself..." — 58:22

- It was in this sense, i.e., to strengthen the believers, that the angels
  were sent to help them in their struggle against the unbelievers, as
  in the verse:
  - $\circ$  "When you sought the aid of your Lord, so He answered you: I will assist you with a thousand of the angels..." 8:9
- The Holy Quran itself explains why the angels were sent:
  - "And Allah made it only a good news for you and that your hearts might be at ease thereby." — 3:126, 8:10

It was through the strengthening of the believers' hearts that the angels worked (8:12).

Fast 21 5



• Angels pray for people in this life:

## وَالْمَلْبِكَةُ يُسَبِّحُونَ عِمَدِرَ بِهِمْ وَيَسْتَغْفِرُونَ لِمَنْ فِي الْأَرْضِ ۗ أَلَآإِنَّ اللهَ هُوَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيْمُ

"...the angels celebrate the praise of their Lord and ask forgiveness for those on earth. Now surely Allah is the Forgiving, the Merciful." -42:5

- "Those on earth" include both the believer and the unbeliever. And while this prayer by the angels is all-comprehensive, it grows stronger in the case of believers. For them, angels pray:
  - "Our Lord, You embrace all things in mercy and knowledge, so protect those
    who turn to You and follow Your way... make them enter the Gardens of perpetuity which You have promised them and such of their fathers and their
    wives and their offspring as are good... and guard them from evil" 40:7–9

Fast 21 6



• And as regards the Holy Prophet, the angels bless him:

## إنَّ اللَّهَ وَمَلَّبِكَتَدُ يُصَلُّونَ عَلَى النَّبِيِّ لَيَايُّهَا الَّذِيْنَ أَمَنُوْا صَلُّوا عَلَيْهِ وَسَلِّمُوْا تَسْلِيمًا عَ

"Surely Allah and His angels bless the Prophet. O you who believe, call for blessings on him and salute him with a (becoming) salutation." — 33:56

• Thus the angels' connection with a person grows stronger as he advances in righteousness. As regards people generally, the angels pray for their forgiveness so that punishment of their evil deeds may be averted. As regards the faithful, they lead them from darkness into light, as stated in 33:43, and thus enable them to make progress spiritually. And as regards the Prophet, they bless him and are thus helpful in advancing his cause in the world.

Fast 21



- The different functions of angels in the spiritual world are connected either with the awakening of the spiritual life in humans or its advancement and progress. This is why faith in angels is required along with a faith in God.
- Faith in angels means that there is a spiritual life for man, and that he
  must develop that life by working according to the promptings of the
  angel. It means that every good suggestion occurring in one's heart

   and such is the suggestion of the angel must be accepted and
  acted upon, because it leads to the spiritual development of man.
